In addition to this, you will be responsible for overseeing three reportee colleagues and collaborating with all members of staff.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Lead the formulation, assignment and implementation of strategic objectives and key results (OKR); that drive performance management, business expansion and innovation.
- Align all approved designs and concepts to the Fund's overall objectives and key
 results by creating metric methods to evaluate staff's delivery of job descriptions
 through tasks and results.
- Oversee the initiation, translation and implementation of research activities that may lead to policy evaluation and or product and programme development for the Fund.

- Support all departments and directorates regarding execution of the Fund's objectives
- Define and design practical roadmaps to the improvement of the organization's structure, resource allocation, commercial activities, etc.
- Show high-level understanding of the Fund's beneficiaries/stakeholders in order to create strategic plans that support existing and new projects/programs.
- Develop actionable recommendations to enhance monitoring of projects/programs, improve operational efficiency and achieve financial targets in collaboration with relevant units.
- Conduct thorough market research and analysis to identify emerging trends, competitive landscapes, and growth opportunities.
